

SELECTION CRITERIA



2023/24 ERIC HIND MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP

- Applicant must be a resident of Merredin Shire or a student of music in Merredin.

 Note applicants attending boarding school who have previously gone to Merredin College or St Mary's Primary School are also eligible to apply.
- **2.** Previous winners are ineligible.
- **3.** Applicant must be at least 7 years of age and under 20 years of age.
- **4.** Applicant must have studied music for at least 12 months.
- 5. Applicant will be required to perform a short piece of music at the interview.
- **6.** If no suitable candidates apply, Council may contribute the funds to the local schools in the district.
- **7.** Part scholarships may be awarded at the discretion of the judges.
- **8.** Applicant must state what the scholarship money will be expended on.
- **9.** Should the contribution be distributed to the selected schools, a feedback report may be required to Council.
- Scholarship money will be issued in two six monthly instalments, unless the successful applicant shows good reason to receive the full amount up front, i.e., purchase of musical instrument.
- 11. After six months, the successful applicant/s will be required to report to Council on the status of their music, if applicable.
- At the completion of twelve months, the successful applicant/s will be required to report to Council stating where the scholarship money was expended.
