What To Put In Your Recycling Bin

- Glass- Bottles and jars etc. (rinsed and lids removed)
- Plastic- Bottles and containers rinsed etc. (with 1, 2 or 3 printed on the bottom/side)
- Paper- Un-soiled, un-tied newspapers, paper, magazines, telephone books etc.
- Cardboard- Un-soiled flattened boxes and cartons etc.
- Aluminium & Steel- Cans, tins, clean foil, aerosol cans etc.
- Liquid paperboard- Milk, juice and laundry detergent cartons etc



What NOT to put in Recycling Bin

- Greenwaste (e.g. Grass clippings, garden cuttings inc. soil and leaves)/Organics/Food Scraps
- Styrofoam
- Electrical Goods
- Computers, Mobile Phones, e-waste
- Nappies
- Steel Products other than steel cans (Recycle at landfill site)
- Food Soiled Pizza boxes
- Plastic Bags
- Clothes
- Cigarette Butts



IF IN DOUBT LEAVE IT OUT OF YOUR RECYCLING BIN!

Designated recycling areas have been provided at both the Chandler Road Landfill site and at certain locations around town sites. These areas are available to everyone. Council encourages everyone to use these areas in order assist in the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions and extend the life of Council's landfill.



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REGULAR RUBBISH AND RECYCLING SERVICES

- Council's waste and recycling services operate all year round.
- Please place your bins out the night before your collection day or before 6AM on the morning of your collection day (lid opening facing the road, a distance of at least 50cm apart between bins).
- Please note Christmas Day is the ONLY public holiday that will affect collection dates.
- Refer to Council newsletters for advice of changes.

ASBESTOS CONTAINING MATERIAL (ACM)

Asbestos Containing Material can be legally disposed of within the designated area at the Chandler Road Waste Management Facility ACM must be separated from other material for disposal. ACM must be wrapped in a manner that prevents asbestos fibres entering the atmosphere. ACM waste or material containing asbestos must be contained and sealed (double-lined or double bagged) in heavy duty, BLACK plastic (at least 0.2mm thick). Wrapped or bagged ACM must be marked with the words 'CAUTION ASBESTOS'. For more information contact the Shire of Merredin on 08 9041 1611.

TYRES

We DO NOT accept tyres at the Chandler Road Waste Management Facility Site. Please contact the Shire of Merredin on 08 9041 1611 for appropriate tyre disposal options.

WASTE OIL COLLECTION

Council operates a residential waste oil collection facility at the Chandler Road Waste Management Facility. Used motor oil can be taken for disposal during Landfill opening hours. There is a per liter charge for disposing anything over 20L for residents with a valid residential tip pass. For more information contact the Shire of Merredin on 08 9041 1611.

drumMUSTER

The drumMUSTER programme is operational within the Shire of Merredin. The collection of farm chemical drums occurs at the Chandler Road Waste Management Facility during operating hours only. For more information contact the Shire of Merredin on 08 9041 1611.

Illegal Dumping

Dumping of any items outside designated waste disposal areas is illegal. Fines of up to \$62,000 (individual) or \$125,000 (corporations) may be imposed on persons found guilty of this offence.

E-Waste Facility

Tip-Shop

The Tip Shop is open daily during the normal Merredin Waste Site operational hours. It is located next to the Gate House.
