6. General Business

General Business and questions from the floor as accepted by the Shire President.

Mr Luke Growden: Did the Nukarni Clubroom Lease go to Council? A group of community members lost access to the rooms with the

T/CEO: The Nukarni Clubrooms are not being leased. It is being utilised by a community group for an arts program on a short-term basis. Any long-term use needs to be approved by the Shire and an MoU or lease would need to be in place.

Ms Michelle Gethin: Requested that the sports be consulted prior to the contract renewal with Belgravia Leisure.

Mr Luke Growden: Raised the matter of CEO recruitment.

Asked about the CEO recruitment process and how long the Shire can operate with a Temporary CEO?

Shire President: The first recruitment process was postponed due to COVID-19. The following process was unsuccessful.

We are now in our third process, and are still working through this. The matter of CEO recruitment is strictly confidential and no information can be revealed. The community will be advised when there is news.

Mr Luke Growden: In regards to the T/CEO, is it constitutional as to how long they can stay on?

Shire President: After 12 months we had to enter into a new contract which was approved by Council.

Cr Ross Billing on behalf of a community member: Noted that they would like somewhere to rest outside IGA.

T/CEO: I would encourage them to write a letter to Council as we are going through the budget process. However, we will take it onboard.

Mr Mark Crees: How is our road maintenance program going? I have approached two Councillors and as to date, nothing has happened at Crees Road.

CEO: I am not aware of that particular request. The grading program is currently behind, and the main reason for that was the need to have the construction teams on funded projects such as Merredin-Narembeen Road, as we had trouble getting contractors in to finish those jobs on-time. Once the weather improves and now that the teams have wrapped up those projects, we are working through the program to catch up.

We don't have an Executive Manager Engineering Services currently, but we are in the process of recruiting. We have been working on a better process internally to manage requests from the community, which is managed through the CEO's office.

Mr Crees noted his frustration that the issue is still unresolved as Crees Road is a school bus run and the request was made on the 18th March.

Mr Luke Growden: Commented that he never received a response from the Snap Send Solve he submitted.

T/CEO: Advised the Shire has been working on improving the Snap Send Solve process and it is now managed through the CEO's office.

Mr Luke Growden: Advised that the ongoing issues with Rutter Road have not been actioned. This has been raised with a couple of the previous works managers and submitted via Snap Send Solve.

Shire President: We will make sure we push that forward for you.

Mr Mark Crees: How are we progressing with the readable water meters? Is there only one being installed?

T/CEO took this on notice and will respond to Mr Crees and include it in the minutes. One standpipe with a card reader has been installed at Hubeck Road.

Ms Yvonne Gray: The process of entering into MoUs with the Shire seem to be long and drawn out.

T/CEO: There are several MoUs being worked on at the present time.
