Wheatbelt Secondary Freight Network

Rick Storer, Chair of Wheatbelt North Regional Road Group and Chair of WSFN attended the Kellerberrin Subgroup meeting and discussed the Governance Plan and the Multi Criteria Analysis methodology for the WSFN funding. Rick took all questions regarding the implementation of the WSFN Governance Plan and MCA Methodology.

There are several categories within the MCA which helps rank projects across the Wheatbelt. Data from the Traffic Speed Deflectometer will be utilized in the Multi Criteria Analysis to help with project ranking. AARB have been engaged to carry out the TSD across 4,400km of roads identified for

WSFN funding. The next stage of the funding delivery is for each of the 42 shires to accept the Governance Plan and MCA Methodology.

2020/21 RRG Project MCAs

Alli Hunt WBN RRG Secretary is currently loading all the Wheatbelt North RRG projects into the spreadsheet. The spreadsheet will be circulated when finished.

Subgroup Project Ranking and Funding Allocations

The Kellerberrin RRG Subgroup 2019/20 RRG funding allocation was dispersed evenly across the 5 shires. The subgroup recognizes there is increased road deterioration across all shires and the existing levels of RRG funding doesn't meet the demand. The Shire of Merredin does have the greatest Asset Preservation Value and the subgroups decision is to allocate the 2020/21 funding as follows,

Merredin 24% Kellerberrin 19% Tammin 19% Cunderdin 19% Dowerin 19%

Managers to resubmit 2020/21 MCAs to reflect the changes to the funding allocations.

General Business

Kellerberrin Subgroup discussed the status of 2019/20 RRG projects. The Shire of Cunderdin has completed one of its projects. The Shire of Dowerin is taking delivery of a stabilizing attachment and Jetpatcher over the next few weeks. Once the equipment is in service the Shire of Dowerin will be able to complete its RRG projects within 2019/20. All other shires are on track to deliver projects on time.
