Policy Statement: To enhance the function, appearance and character of the

Merredin Town Centre as a retail centre and encourage these services to be presented in a manner which will add colour, life,

diversity and interest to the town centre.

Objectives: To allow the display of merchandise by local retail outlets on

Shire controlled footpaths whilst ensuring pedestrian safety.

Guidelines: Stall holders must comply with the below guidelines:

 Ensure pedestrian safety by providing a minimum unimpeded width of 2 metres adjacent to displays on the footpaths;

1.2. The provision of a copy of the business insurance policy (with a minimum public liability of \$5m-\$10m), indemnifying Council against any liability arising form the display of merchandise on the footpath; and

2-3. The display of retail goods is strictly limited to the width of the property of the particular business premises.
