Water Corporation is in the process of planning upgrades to the Goldfields pipeline.

We are hoping to replace a section of pipeline which runs along a Shire of Merridan property – Reserve 18613 currently vested with the Shire as a Management Order and its current purpose being Public Utility.

The new section of pipeline will be installed below ground, and in close proximity, where possible to the existing pipeline route. We are hoping to begin the commencement of works as soon as possible to further support the growing demand for water in the regions.

We are seeking to obtain formal consent from the Shire to support the proposed pipeline installation on the parcel and for an easement to be placed over the pipeline, once installed, to allow Water Corporation access to the pipeline, for maintenance and for the protection of the pipeline.
