Comment

The attached are self-explanatory in that the intent of the proposal is understood. However, implementation may be counter-productive to the cohesion and relationships within a Council should such determinations not be made by an independent arbiter or panel.

The proposal is for a President/Mayor or deputy or another Councillor as nominated by the Council to rule on complaints. Independence is key as any determination could be seen as fostering specific interests if not made by a disassociated party. This holds particularly true of acceptance of rulings by the public.

The proposal if successful will amend the Local Government Act and the Rules of Conduct.

The costs of peer review panels are borne by the relevant Council.
