200 medical students from Curtin Medical School and The University of Notre Dame Australia Fremantle School of Medicine will participate in a rural immersion experience in Bruce Rock, Cunderdin, Corrigin, Kellerberrin, Merredin, Moora, Narrogin, Southern Cross and Westonia.

Students will be billeted with local residents who can provide them with valuable first-hand experience of rural life and issues. During their stay, students will experience a farm safety course and visit local general practices, hospitals and schools. On their final night in your town, the students will host a community dinner to say thank you for your generosity and support.
